ABOUT JOHN MAWSON

John Mawson was New Zealand Director of Town Planning in 1928. With few resources he advocated with local authorities to take up their town planning responsibilities and promoted the concept of regional planning. He was one of the founders of what is now the NZPI having created the first Town Planning Institute in the 1930's.

To build the profile of the planning profession, he edited the Town Planning Institute's journal, Community Planning, and assisted a number of New Zealanders to complete their Town Planning Institute exams, which were the only way to qualify as a planner until Auckland University established its planning course. He was one of town planning's greatest advocates and for most of his career he worked with the minimum of resources.

ABOUT THE AWARD

The Te Kokiringa Taumata | New Zealand Planning Institute John Mawson Award of Merit is made from time to time to any organisation or persons in recognition of a meritorious individual or one-off contribution to the theory or practice of planning. Nominated organisations must include at least one NZPI member, while nominated individuals must be NZPI members. The grant will be formally presented at the 2022 Annual Conference in Christchurch.

THE CRITERIA

Applicants for this award must provide 1–3 pages (no more) outlining the individual or one-off contribution to the theory or practice of planning that the award is to recognise. The nomination must identify the NZPI member involved. If the nomination is in recognition of an individual contribution it must also include an up to date copy of the nominee's CV.

Please note: All applications must be made on this form. Only applications with all the required supporting material will be accepted. Completed applications must be received by 5pm 10 January 2022. The decision of the Awards Committee is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
